What is a Pollinator Garden? A mix of 38 native Wildflowers from Southern Ontario chosen to enhance the landscape of shady areas.

Why plant a Shade Garden? Different plants have different shade tolerances. Certain species thrive in shady conditions and are more appropriate for forest understory habitat.

Renaissance style landscaping in North America has replaced important natural habitats with ornamental species that are non-native to our ecosystems. Most of these species have evolved outside of the formed relationship that native plants and animals have. Thus, these non-native species do not provide the necessary food and habitat to continue healthy natural systems.

Make your yard into a forest paradise!!!

Native Flower Species May include: thimbleweed, Canadian anemone, eastern columbine, tall meadow rue, virginia water leaf, Pennsylvania sedge, Canadian violet, white snakeroot, zig zag goldenrod and hear leaved aster.
